**These minutes represent the general subject matter discussed in this meeting but do not reflect a verbatim documentation of the subjects and conversation that took place.**

1. Chairman Cassie Fleming called the Regular Town Board Meeting to order at 6 P.M. Present were Supervisor Steven Probst, Tess Eisenhaue, Supervisor Nicole Vee, and Clerk/Treasurer Helen G Hyde. Clerk testified the meeting was properly posted. Rusty Williams was absent
2. A motion by Steven Probst, seconded by Nicole Vee to approve the Agenda, Motion carried.
3. A motion by Tess Eisenhauer, seconded by Nicole Vee to approve the Minutes of the Regular Town Board meeting February 12, 2015 . Motion carried.
4. A motion by Steven probst, seconded by Nicole Vee to approve the Financial Report. Motion Carried.
5. No Citizens comments
6. Faith Pittsley representing the Lions Club presented a picture of the banner they are intending to use on the light poles of Highway 2. They hope to have them hung by June 1, 2015.
7. A motion by Steven Probst, seconded by Nicole Vee to recommend approval for Andrew and Nancy Lind, 69485 East Long Lake Road for a lessor setback than required by Ordinance to construct a 2 story building. The Planning Commission has also approved this request. Motion carried.
8. A motion by Steven Probst, seconded by Tess Eisenhauer to recommend approval for Roy and Allen Wicklund at 69760 Island Blvd to request a lessor setback than required by Ordinance to build a new cabin on a lot with 65 feet of frontage. The planning Commission has also approved this request. Motion carried.
9. A motion by Steven Probst, secondwed by Nicole Vee to table the request from Joseph and Sarah Zuelke at 65900 County Highway A, a special use permit for a hobby farm. Motion carried.

10. A motion by Steven Probst, seconded by Tess Eisenhauer to rezone 10 parcels in the Town of Iron River to Municipal. A copy of those parcels can be obtained in the Clerk's Office. These parcels will then be presented to Bayfield County Zoning for approval. Motion carried.
11. A motion by Steven Probst, seconded by Nicole Vee on request from Mr Peterson regarding the building at 8140 US Highway 2, Town Board is asking Mr Peterson to come and speak to Board of Review this summer. Clerk will write a letter explaining this to Mr Peterson. Motion carried.
12. A motion by Steven Probst, seconded by Tess Eisenhauer to accept the bid from Ray Brunette of Grafton, WI. For \$5150.00 for the sale of the plow truck and plow on the Wisconsin surplus site. Motion carried.
13. A motion by Steven Probst, seconded by Tess Eisenhauer, to relocated money from insurance, not Medical, to pay for the emergency heater repair. Motion carried.
14. Gary Victorson is in the process of putting bid requests for furnaces in the paper to be opened in the May 2015 Regular Town Board Meeting.
15. A motion by Steven Probst, seconded by Nicole Vee to table the request for a free dump day in the Town of Iron River until further information can be obtained. Motion carried.
16. A motion by Steven Probst, seconded by Nicole Vee to increase the fees at Moon Lake Park for the 2015 Summer Season. New rates are available in the Clerk's Office. Motion carried.
17. A motion by Steven Probst, seconded by Nicole Vee to approve Todd Gibbon to inspect the Iron River Dam for the bi-annual safety inspection. Motion carried.
18. Community Center Roof= A motion by Steven Probst, seconded by Tess Eisenhauer, recommendation from Mr. Schrafngel for types of roof available, writing up specs for project, seeking bids and then back to the Board for final approval. Motion carried. Ball Field Building= Bids due on April 2, 2015, they will be opened at CNS Design in Ashland and then brought to the April Town Board Meeting for approval. Dump Station= Underground dump stations are being looked at. Will be installed in the summer after bids are opened.
