These minutes represent the general subject matter discussed in this meeting but do not reflect a verbatim documentation of the subjects and conversation that took place.

1. Chairman Steven Probst called the Regular Town Board Meeting to order at 6 P.M. Present were Supervisor John Rautio, Rusty Williams, Michelle Davis, Nicole Vee, and Clerk/Treasurer Helen G Hyde. Clerk testified the meeting was properly posted.
2. A motion by Rusty Williams, seconded by John Rautio to approve the Agenda, Motion carried.
3. A motion by Nicole Vee, seconded by Michelle Davis to approve the Minutes of the Regular Town Board meeting February 11, 2016 and the Special Town Board Meeting February 15, 2016 and the Special Town Board Meeting February 26, 2016 . Motion carried.

6. A motion by Michelle Davis, seconded by Nicole Vee to accept the bid from Waste Management, declining Eagle Waste, for a 5 year contract. A lengthy discussion was held with all the information being presented by both interested parties. The Board reviewed a spread sheet with all the prices listed. Motion carried.
7. A motion by Nicole Vee, Seconded by Michelle Davis to Table the request from the Sanitary District for approval of an Ordinance to protect our groundwater located near and around our wells from potential contamination. Motion carried.
8. Motion by Rusty Williams, seconded by Michelle Davis to recommend approval for Bayfield Electric to rezone from R1 to Industrial for a solar Community Garden for the Eastern most part of that parcel but the other parts not to be rezoned. Motion carried.
9. A motion by Nicole Vee, seconded by Michelle Davis to approve a Resolution to adopt a FT Fund Choice 457 Program for the Town's Employees, this is at no cost to the Town of Iron River. Motion carried.

10. A motion by John Rautio, seconded by Nicole Vee to move forward with the second phase of the sidewalk project. Letter will be sent out to the next group of people on the North side of US Highway 2, going west. Motion carried.
11. No action on the emergency generator.
12. A motion by Michelle Davis, seconded by John Rautio to enter into closed session, Sec 19.85 (1), for the purpose of Employee Hiring, Wage, Wisconsin Retirement. Discussion
A motion by John Rautio, seconded by Rusty Williams to Reconvene, Sec 19.85 (2).
Motion carried.
13. Head of Department present: Tony Williams-Police, Gary Victorson- Ambulance, John Darwin- Fire, Mike Middleman-Highway, Scott Williams-Custodian. A certificate of Appreciation was presented to Mike Middleman for his 21 years of dedicated service to the Town of Iron River. He will be leaving the Town on April 1, 2016. We will miss him greatly.
