**These minutes represent the general subject matter discussed in this meeting but do not reflect a verbatim documentation of the subjects and conversation that took place.**

1. Chairman Steven Probst called the Regular Town Board Meeting to order at 6 P.M. Present were Supervisor John Rautio, Lori Anderson, Michelle Davis and Clerk/Treasurer Helen G Hyde. Clerk testified the meeting was properly posted. Rusty Williams was absent.
2. A motion by John Rautio, seconded by Michelle Davis to approve the Agenda, Motion carried.
3. A motion by Lori Anderson, seconded by John Rautio to approve the Minutes of the Regular Town Board meeting June 8, 2017. Motion carried.
4. A motion by John Rautio, seconded by Lori Anderson to approve the Financial Report. Motion Carried.
5. Citizens Comments. None
6. A motion by John Rautio, seconded by Lori Anderson to deny the request from Jodi Brown and a special use permit for a Hobby Farm. After considering relevant public input from the neighbors and the fact that the request conflicts with the Town of Iron River future land use plan the Town Board does not recommend approving this request. Motion carried.
7. Update on the Bayfield County Zoning Shore Land Ordinance Amendment. The County has sent over the papers for the Ordinance and wanted to make sure the Town Board is aware of the change.
8. A motion by Lori Anderson, seconded by Michelle Davis to approve a request from the Iron River Lions club for a Temporary Class B License for the Blueberry Festival on July 22, 23, 2017. Motion carried.
9. A motion by Lori Anderson, seconded by John Rautio to approve the Special Event Permit from the Lions Club for the Parade held on July 23, 2017. Motion carried.

10. A motion by Lori Anderson, seconded by Michelle Davis to accept the bid by Northwood's Paving for \$51,303.02 to wedge and overlay approximately .47 miles of South Point Drive, 18 feet wide in one pass. Motion carried.
11. A motion by Lori Anderson, seconded by Michelle Davis to approve the Special Event Permit requested by Carignan's for a Street Dance held on July 21, 2017 from 8:30 PM – 1:30 AM. Open Container with no glass outside of building, written signage on barricades that state no open container past this point. Town will provide garbage cans. Motion carried.
12. A motion by Michelle Davis, seconded by John Rautio to Table the request from the Lions Club for contributions to the playground located at the Community Center. Motion carried. Motion carried.
13. A motion by John Rautio seconded by Lori Anderson to sell 125 old torn beige chairs from the Community Center. 150 new chairs were purchased to replace them. Motion carried.
14. A motion by John Rautio, seconded by Lori Anderson to appoint Scott Ogren to the Planning Commission. Motion carried.
15. Update on Highway 2 project. The State decided not to do all the extra's they had decided upon prior, which included sidewalks, gutters and curbs. The State has decided they will only replace failed gutters and now just overlay. Chairman Probst said he was in the process of writing letters and trying to appeal the States decision.

18. A motion by Lori Anderson, seconded by Michelle Davis to adjourn at 7:30 P.M. Motion carried.
