1. Chairman Steven Probst called the Regular Town Board Meeting to order at 6 P.M. Present were Supervisor John Rautio, Michelle Davis, Rusty Williams and Clerk/Treasurer Helen G Hyde. Clerk testified the meeting was properly posted. Lori Anderson was absent.
2. A motion by John Rautio, seconded by Rusty Williams to approve the Agenda, Motion carried.
3. A motion by Michelle Davis, seconded by Rusty Williams to approve the Minutes of the Regular Town Board meeting August 10, 2017, Special Town Board Meeting August 17, 2017, and Special Town Board Meeting August 29, 2017. Motion carried.
4. A motion by John Rautio, seconded by Rusty Williams to approve the Financial Report. Motion Carried.
5. Citizens Comments. None
6. A motion by Rusty Williams, seconded by Michelle Davis to recommend approval for a Shoreline grading to prep for future house site. This was approved by the Planning Commission. Motion carried.
7. A motion by Rust Williams, seconded by Michelle Davis to recommend approval on a special exceptions and variance submitted by Stephen and Andrea Tomlinson to request a lesser setback than required by an Ordinance. This was approved by the Planning Commission. Motion carried.
8. A motion by John Rautio, seconded by Rusty Williams to recommend approval a preliminary plat approval requested by Julie Mellum for a lot reconfiguration with no additional lots being created. Motion carried.

A motion by John Rautio, seconded by Rusty Williams to approve the request from the Trails North ATV club for a Special Event Permit to close Railroad Street between Main Street and Lea Street, into the alley, for their annual event. There will be open container and signs will be posted for staying within the boundaries of the event. Motion carried.
10. A motion by Michelle Davis, seconded by John Rautio to approve the request from the Half Moon Lake District to hang signs at Half Moon lake to help protect the loons. Motion carried.
11. Chairman Steve Probst explained a letter the Town received from the DOT regarding the Highway 2 resurfacing project. The letter explained that the funds the town was asking for to replace a few items on Highway 2 are just not available and the extra work will not be done.
